International collaborative PhD The status quo, challenges and needs

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The current situation

Currently 2254 post grad students
Of 33811 total (6,67%)
295 doctoral students (13,09%)
Qualifications include DTech, Professional
Doctorate and PhD





The current situation

Currently 843 permanent academic staff
214 hold doctorate (25,39%)
85 has doctorate +5 years (10,08%)
Not all departments offer doctorate
qualifications





The current situation

No formal collaborative international PhDs currently reported at CPUT

Some ad-hoc is in process:

e.g. staff who participate in international collaboration during PhD studies

Staff who host international students (registered for non-degree purposes)

Structured partnerships


Partners who address the gaps we currently have e.g. PhD Maritime Studies
